Across the last 28 years, it has been my privilege to fulfill Executive Director responsibilities at Lucille Raines Residence. Coupled with search for new leadership was recognition of service across these years. June's first weekend was full – Mission luncheon at Annual Conference, June 7 Open House at LRR, etc. Gratitude was expressed in numerous ways. Yes, I have been overwhelmed with your good wishes!

Transition: July 7, Jodie Little assumed responsibilities as Lucille Raines Executive Director. My prayer is that LRR's mission and ministry will continue to flourish.

As I reflect on the beginnings of the Raines ministry 48 years ago, I see the Hand of God every step of the way.

- Evelyn Saffer's vision of a ministry for folk in recovery
- Co-operation with The Salvation Army the first 2 years for beginning a new thing
- Opportunity for several thousand folk to experience freedom from addictive behaviors – substance use disorders

My heart is full in remembering folk for whom the Raines experience has been transformative. Experience some of these through *Road to Hope* and *Road to Hope Continues* vignettes. Untold numbers voice, "I wouldn't be alive had it not been for Raines!"

There have been opportunities to support residents in the most tender moments of life – illness and death – and opportunities to rejoice with successes – employment, clean time, etc. Challenge and fulfillment in creative tension!

As I take leave, a part of me remains. I reflect on a missionary who faithfully served in Africa. Having become very ill, commitment overcame logic. She remained at the task beyond the time when she could be medically helped by returning to the US. Her request to her husband: Upon death, appropriate to return her body to their home, as her family would expect that. However, prior to that, remove her heart, for it was to be buried where she'd served.



I'll not be that dramatic. However, a part of me will always be at Raines.

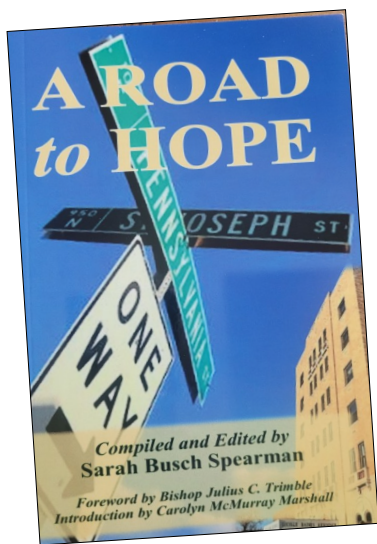

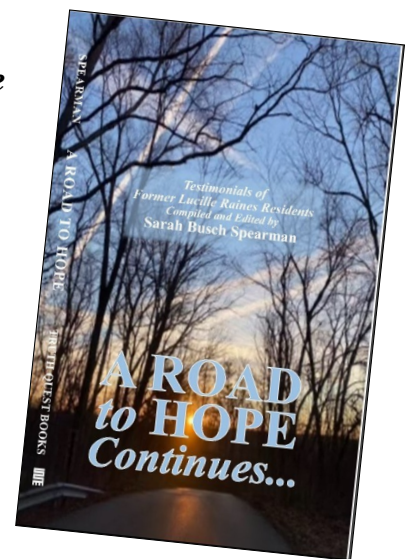
